TAFE SA is pleased to offer students the opportunity to complete a Certificate II in Horticulture (AHC20416) by participating in the Outdoor Skills Development Program Butterfly Garden Project.

The butterfly garden project has been developed to provide students with knowledge across a variety of areas within horticulture. The foundation skills developed have been designed to prepare students for their next step in study or work within the horticulture industry.

As part of the program students design, build and plant at TAFE SA Urrbrae campus covering aspects such as collecting and propagating seeds, and constructing, planting and maintenance of the butterfly garden.
