- 1. Tell us about your interest in and commitment to agriculture, horticulture, agtech and/or the environment. This can include any involvement in any community programs that relate to school foci for example eg CFS, Trees for Life and/or your involvement in any family activities that relate to school foci for example camping, fishing, animal care, horticultural projects.
